5. AB 858

Assemblyman Ford suggested if we are to consider <u>AB 858</u> she would offer amendments. She proposed we take pages 1 and 2 down to line 27 and amend and do pass that part of the bill and eliminate everything relating to any charter office and local offices. She distributed check sheets so committee members could make up their minds concerning this proposal. (copy attached.)She stated there is a conflict where the constitution says any elector according to present rules says 18 and NRS says 25. She feels anyone would have a good case in going to court and feels it should be consistent, stating there are many offices 18 years old can already run for and if we amend and do pass out Sec. 1 thru 7, we would be making at least part of it consistent with the constitution.

Assemblyman Crawford: I am for it, but when do we get the complete bill the next time?

Assemblyman Ford: I've discussed it with Mr. Ullom and he will be willing to support emasculating the bill to this point. Madam Chairman, will you allow us to take this up at the next Elections Committee meeting one way or the other?

Chairman Foote: I will give it consideration.
