Chairman Bremner called the meeting to order at 8:20 a.m. on this Wednesday morning. He announced that today the committee will take in consideration Assembly bills 460, 461, 462, 464, 465, and 466.

A.B. 460

Mrs. Ford motioned for a "do pass as amended" with the amendment being the delete "fur-bearing animals" on page 1, line 10. Mr. Jacobsen seconded Mrs. Ford's motion. Unaminous agreement with the members.

A.B. 461

Mr. Jacobsen motioned for a "do pass" on A.B. 461 and Mr. Lowman seconded his motion.

Mrs. Ford asked Mr. Frank Groves if he had any suggested amendments for this bill, and the answer was they did not.

A.B. 462

This was moved by Mr. Lowman for an "indefinite postponement", and Dr. Broadbent seconded.

A.B. 464

This bill was moved for a "do pass" by Mrs. Gojack, and it was seconded by Mr. Jacobsen.

A.B. 465

Dr. Broadbent moved for a "do pass as amended", with the amendment is to change, on line 5 of page 1, the fee of \$5.00 to a fee of \$25.00. Mr. Jacobsen seconded Dr. Broadbent's motion.

Chairman Bremner called the committee's attention to a letter he received by Mr. Fred Wright, suggesting the amendments by the Department of Fish and Game. (This letter is attached as Exhibit I)

This letter stated a fee of \$25.00 for a commercial taxidermist license, and a fee of \$5.00 for a non-commercial license. To this, Mr. Lowman moved for an overall fee of \$25.00, with the exemption of the learning institutions. Mr. Jacobsen seconded Mr. Lowman's motion.

Mrs. Ford brought up A.B. 141, line 25, and said that this phrase might be able to fit it: This states that this shall not apply: to institutions of learning of this state or of the United States, or research activity conducted for purely scientific purposes or in the advancement of agriculture, botany or any of the sciences.

Chairman Bremner asked if the department, or any staff have considered the language of A.B. 141, and Mr. Groves said they do not believe there is any problem with it, and they have no objections. He also said that if the members want \$25.00 for the fee, that is alright, too, with the exemption of the schools.

After discussion of hobbyists, and Mr. Lowman's statement about "for others" in the bill, Mr. Wright suggested that instead of "for others, to put "renumeration". Mrs. Ford said that then you would have to say in Section 1-- "refer to those described in Section 3".

Mr. Jacobsen said that he agreed to the statement from A.B. 141, and then Mr. Lowman declared that he withdraw his motion. Mr. Jacobsen moved that at this time that they leave the language as such; that commercial licenses are \$25.00 and non-commercial licenses at \$5.00. And then include section from A.B. 144 of Section 4 (b). Mrs. Ford seconded his motion.

Mr. Lowman, in reference to Mr. Jacobsen's motion, proposed that they make the word "research activity" to "research activities". Ther Mr. Wright added that they could also rephrase "botany" to "biology." Committee members agreed.

A.B. 466

Mrs. Gojack motioned for a "do pass" and Mr. Crawford seconded it. Mr. Jacobsen did not like the language too well, and the chairman asked if he wanted to amend it, but after discussion Mr. Jacobsen accepted it as it was. Unaminous agreement between the members.


Chairman Bremner announced the joint hearing today at Senate adjournment about the Land Use Bill, and said there will be no meeting Friday.

Dear Assemblyman Bremner:

The following revision of A.B. 465 is submitted in compliance with the committee's request of March 9, 1973:

Section 1. Chapter 502 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section which shall read as follows:

- A taxidermist license is required before any person may perform a taxidermy service on wildlife or their parts, nests, or eggs for any person other than himself.
- 2. Annual licenses for the term of one (1) year from July 1 to June 30 shall be issued by the department at the following fees:

(a) Commercial Taxidermist License

\$25.00

(b) Noncommercial Taxidermist License

\$ 5.00

3. The commission may establish regulations covering receipt, transportation, possession, identification and sale of wildlife which is to be or has been processed by a taxidermist.
