The meeting was called to order by the chairman.

AB 62 - Amends the new charter of the City of Las Vegas.

Mr. Adams told the committee that the City of Las Vegas was satisfied with the charter amendments except that they would like an amendment so that the City Attorney be allowed to have a private practice.

Assemblyman Smith presented an amendment to change the word proceeding with the word succeeding on line 1, page 5.

Assemblyman Ullom questioned the two year residency requirement for municipal officers. The committee asked Mr. Wooster for his opinion as to the constitutionality of that requirement. He explained that, in so far as he knew, it had never been questioned.

Assemblyman Getto moved that Amendment #28 be passed.

Assemblyman May seconded the motion.

The motion carried unanimously.

Assemblyman Brookman moved for an amendment to allow the city attorney to have a private practice.

Assemblyman Smith seconded the motion.

The motion passed with Assemblyman Ullom voting No.

Assemblyman Ford moved that an amendment be adopted to allow person who lived in an annexed area to be considered as having two year residency in Las Vegas.

Assemblyman Smith seconded the motion.

The motion carried with Assemblyman Ullom voting No.

Assemblyman Young moved AB 62 "DO PASS AS AMENDED"

Assemblyman Getto seconded the motion.

The motion passed with Assemblyman Ullom voting No.

AB 1 - Amends the city charter of the city of Henderson.

Assemblyman Smith presented the amendment for the bill.

He explained that this amendment would provide for action taken at emergency meeting of the city council to be vetoed by any member who was not able to attend the meeting.

Assemblyman Smith moved "DO PASS AS AMENDED"

Assemblyman May seconded the motion.

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The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned.
