The meeting was called to order by the chairman.

AB 76 - Authorizes 4-day work week of 10 hours per day  
for public employees.

Assemblyman Getto told the committee that his sub-committee  
would report back on this bill on Tuesday.

AB 359 - Enlarges provisions for emergency medical care.

Assemblyman Getto moved to "INDEFINITELY POSTPONE".  
Assemblyman Ullom seconded the motion.  
The motion carried unanimously.

AB 81 - Makes establishment of ground water boards discretionary.

Assemblyman Smith told the committee that the State Engineer  
had requested that this bill be passed.  
Assemblyman Ullom stated he felt that the boards should be  
mandatory instead of discretionary.  
Assemblyman Getto moved "DO PASS AS AMENDED"  
Assemblyman Smith seconded the motion.  
Assemblymen Dini, Brookman, May, Gojack, Smith, Getto voted YES.  
Assemblymen Ford and Ullom voted NO.  
The motion carried.

AB 221 - Requires governing body of city or county to enforce  
restrictive covenants in deeds.

Assemblyman Ford moved for an "INDEFINITE POSTPONEMENT".  
Assemblyman Ullom seconded the motion.  
The motion carried unanimously.

AB 278 - Prohibits discrimination between men and women  
in real property transactions.

Assemblyman Gojack moved "DO PASS."  
Assemblyman Ullom seconded the motion.  
The motion carried unanimously.

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AB 281 - Expands authority of Nevada commission on equal rights of citizens over discrimination in employment.

Assemblyman May moved for an "INDEFINITE POSTPONEMENT".  
Assemblyman Smith seconded the motion.  
Assemblymen Dini, May, Smith and Getto voted YES.  
Assemblymen Ullom, Brookman, Gojack and Ford voted NO.  
The motion did not carry.

AB 376 - Provides records destruction procedures and enables records management program for local governments.

Assemblyman Smith moved "DO PASS".  
Assemblyman Ford seconded the motion.  
The motion carried unanimously.
