Meeting called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Chairman Bennett for the purpose of discussing AB 260.

Drs. Gwen O'Bryan and Chuck Dickson, of the Division of Mental Hygiene and Mental Retardation appeared as witnesses for the bill.

Dr. Dickson said the bill was basically to enable their Division to run a facility in Las Vegas to treat severely emotionally disturbed children. At the present time there is no such facility, and these children are being placed out of state at a cost to Welfare of \$132,000. There are 17 in private institutions in Nevada at an estimated cost of \$45,000.

They plan four cottage type homes with a high quality staff, and the children would come in as inpatients for a small period of time, then go to a halfway station and then return home where they would be visited and treated as outpatients. The staff would counsel and train the children and also their parents, or potential foster parents.

They would prefer the facility in East Las Vegas because that is where the greatest density of population is for this retarded group, and also the greatest concentration of schools.

Questioned about the fiscal note, Dr. Dickson stated that the Governor had recommended \$340,000 for the first year, \$208,000 of which would come from general appropriation and \$132,000 from social services. For the second year, the Governor recommended \$296,000 from general appropriation and \$176,000 from social services. The bost of building would be approximately one million dollars.

Mr. Getto questioned the effectiveness of the program and asked if there were any figures on the percentage of children who could return to school or improved. Dr. O'Bryan said

there had been research on this, and out of 40 children treated, 38 were able to return to community.

Dr. Dickson stated this program would be focusing on children in early school years, and that there are 2000 in the county that could use some help. The inpatient service would be short, but the main service is in outside follow-through and treatment. It will not solve all problems for all children, but will solve some problems for a few, which is a start.

The Planning Board is now working on drawings for the facility, and Dr. Dickson showed tentative plans to the Committee.

The witnesses were excused.

Chairman Bennett stated he had received the requested amendment to AB 213 from the bill drafters and would entertain motions. Mr. McNeel made a motion "Amend and do pass" which was seconded by Mr. Getto. All members present voted "Yes".

On AB 260, a motion was made by Mr. Hickey "Do Pass" and seconded by Mr. Wittenberg. All members present voted "Yes".

Chairman Bennett passed around a bill pertaining to expanding public child welfare and youth services, and asked if the Committee would like to introduce such bill. Mr. Wittenberg moved that the Committee introduce the bill, and Mr. Hickey seconded the motion. Unanimously approved.

Meeting adjourned at 8:45 a.m.
