Chairman Bennett called the meeting to order for a discussion of AB-439.

Mr. Gregory of the State Health Division stated they did not have the staff to enforce this bill, and if the Committee decided to pass it they had several amendments they would like considered. There is now legislation covering the sterilization of used mattresses and he felt this bill ^(AB 439) was completely unnecessary and unenforceable. The State Health Department does not want the responsibility of enforcing this bill.

Mr. Wittenberg felt this bill would put the small upholster out of business since this bill pertained to new upholstery as well as old, and the license fee plus labeling and setting up a sterilization chamber would be prohibitive.

SB-68 was the next matter discussed. Mr. Wittenberg read the sections of the act sought to be repealed by this bill. Mr. Wahrenbrock of the Department of Health & Welfare stated there had never been any funds allotted to enforce these provisions and his Department wanted to be relieved of the responsibility. Most cities and counties require a business license to sell the products covered and the responsibility should go back to that level. He understood Senator Walker had written to a number of organizations for the blind and none of them had any objection to this bill.

Senator Lee E. Walker appeared and confirmed that none of the organizations for the blind that he had contacted objected to repealing the sections covered. No one ever came to the State for a license.

The Committee discussed the Senate's proposed amendment to AB 184.

All witnesses were excused, and the Committee took the following action:
