## MINUTES

Mr. Hayes scheduled a report from the sub-committee on criminal law for Monday, February 26, 1973 at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Judiciary Committee.

Mr. Lowman reported that he had received the requested amendment to A.B. 174, in the form of amendment # 116. Short general discussion followed. It was decided that the amendment was satisfactory.

Mr. Lowman moved to recommend DO PASS, Mr. Huff seconded. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
