

## SENATE COMMERCE AND LABOR COMMITTEE

## MINUTES OF MEETING

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 28, 1973

The meeting was called to order at 12:15 p.m.

S. B. 270 - Makes certain provisions concerning wages, hours and working conditions of female employees in private employment applicable to all employees.

Senator Herr Spoke in favor of the bill as amended. Everything was removed from the bill except that portion concerning wages.

S. B. 405 - Provides that insurance commissioner may review proposed cancellations of insurance policies.

Senator Wilson appeared and spoke in favor of the bill. He said it was simply to give an insured a chance to to and have a review of why his insurance policy is dropped. He suggested amendments to the effect that for non-payment of premiums, loss of driver's license or failure to renew should be excluded.

Oliver Bolton, representing the Nevada Independent Insurance Agents, spoke in opposition to the bill. He stated that at the present time the insured has a right to go to the Commissioner of Insurance with any complaint.

James Lorigan, representing Farmer's Group, spoke in behalf of Milo Turzich who feels that all this is covered under the Federal Insurance Code.

Mike Melner, Commerce Director, was instructed to discuss this bill with Commissioner Rottman.

S. B. 283 - Provides for creation of industrial development corporations.

Senator Neal appeared and spoke in favor of this bill which is an administrative bill.

Mike Melner appeared and spoke in favor of the bill.

Motion, Senator Swobe, Do Pass, seconded Senator Blakemore carried unanimously.

S. B. 536 - Limits scope of provision barring application of tips to minimum wages.

Motion, Senator Swobe, Do Pass, seconded Senator Blakemore, carried unanimously.

S. B. 291 - Requires certain enterprises to invest portion of profit in socially beneficial projects.

Motion Senator Swobe, Do Kill, seconded Senator Blakemore carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
