Minutes of Meeting

April 17, 1973

Senator Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

AB 477 Provides commission with authority to promulgate engine and exhaust emission standards for motor vehicle pollution control. (Fiscal Note: No. (BDR 40-1330)

Testimony was heard explaining the purpose of this bill; monies involved; and, suggested amendments to the bill, from Robert Guinn of the Nevada Motor Transport Association, Howard Hill, Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles and John Ciardella, Chief of Registration, Department of Motor Vehicles.

As there was no testimony against this measure, the following amendments were adopted:

1. Page 1, Line 15; Page 4, Lines 32 and 33; and, Page 4, Line 42 to change the wording "state commission of environmental protection" to state Environmental commission.
2. Page 3, Line 13 to read "....to the provisions of NRS 706.801 to 706.861, inclusive [.] and which are based in this state."
3. Page 3, Lines 32 and 33, change word "licensed" to "authorized".
4. Page 2, Line 43, change date of "September 1, 1973" to "February 1, 1974."

With these amendments adopted Senator Bryan moved Do Pass with amendments and refer to Senate Finance Committee for fiscal note action.

Seconded by Senator Echols.

Motion Carried.

AB 951 Reorganizes structure of state and county fish and game administration.

After discussion amongst the committee members regarding this bill, and there being no testimony from the floor:

Senator Young moved Do Kill

Seconded by Senator Bryan

Motion Carried.

Chairman Wilson then asked the secretary to put the following bills on the agenda for the following day, April 18, 1973, to meet upon p.m. adjournment of the Senate, and also notify the respective witnesses for testimony:

AB 557 - Notify Mr. Zappitini and Assemblyman Ford

AB 903 - Notify Assemblyman Bremner

AB 851 - Notify Fish and Game Commission

AB 896 - Notify Fish and Game Commission & Assemblyman Young.

AB 680 - Notify Mining Inspector

Chairman Wilson then informed the committee that the Assembly had passed SB 548 and SB 434 but that they had made minor amendments to both bills. After reading the proposed amendments by the Assembly, the committee concurred on both these amendments.

Chairman Wilson then went over a new proposed bill which the committee okayed for introduction.

SB 613 Creates a vendor's warranty that water will be available to purchasers of certain subdivision parcels.

There was no testimony from the floor, but Senator Wilson had received a proposed amendment to this bill which he read to the committee:


1. Page 1, Line 3, delete words "vendor of" and substitute the words "any subdivider who sells."

The amendment being approved, the following action took place:

Senator Bryan moved "Do Pass with amendment."
