

SENATE PUBLIC RESOURCES AND ECOLOGY COMMITTEE

MINUTES OF MEETING

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 18, 1973

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

Senator Wilson in the chair.

PRESENT: Senator Echols
Senator Bryan
Senator Young

A. B. 557 - Adds to requirements for control of erosion in timbering operations.

George Zappattini, State Forestry Division, appeared and spoke in support of the measure. He stated that the bill would be helpful in control of logging operations.

Motion Senator Young, Do Pass, seconded by Senator Bryan, carried.

A. B. 903 - Allows Nevada department of fish and game to issue sportsmen certificates.

Frank Groves, Director of Fish and Game Department, appeared and spoke in support of the legislation. He stated that he had several requests from people who neither fish nor hunt, but desired to help the program. This bill would enable the people to do this.

Motion, Senator Young, Do Pass, seconded by Senator Bryan, carried.

A. B. 851 - Removes disposal procedure for certain old hunting and fishing records.

Motion, Senator Young, Do Pass, seconded by Senator Bryan, carried.

A. B. 896 - Enacts enabling provisions for complying with Federal Animal Damage Control Act of 1973.

Frank Groves, Director of Fish and Game, appeared and spoke in support of the measure with the following amendment requested:

Page 5, line 35, the number 16 be changed to read "15".

Motion, Senator Echols, Amend and Do Pass, seconded by Senator Young, carried.

A.J.R. 49 - Memorializes Secretary of Interior to promulgate certain regulations.

Motion, Senator Young, Do Pass, seconded Senator Echols, carried.
