The second meeting of the Committee on Education was held on February 8, 1973, at 2:40 p.m.

Chairman Foley called the meeting to order at 2:40 p.m. He presented the following schedule to the committee members for approval:

- February 13 - S.C.R. 4, Directs senate and assembly education committees to study establishment of law school as part of University of Nevada System;
- February 15 - S.B. 134, Creates Nevada National Guard educational encouragement fund to help defray student's costs;
- February 20 - Joint hearing with Assembly regarding twelve-month school;
- February 22 - S.B. 170, prohibits state board of education from adopting rules and regulations relating to matters outside its jurisdiction;
- February 27 - S.J.R. 6, memorializes Congress to enact legislation prohibiting busing of public school children for purposes of racial balance;
S.J.R. 7, requests Congress to call constitutional convention to provide for anti-busing amendment;
S.J.R. 8, memorializes Congress to propose constitutional amendment prohibiting busing of public school children for purposes of racial balance.

March 1 - Vocational duplication hearing and relationship between school districts, Community College and University.


Upon approval of the foregoing schedule by the committee members, Chairman Foley adjourned the meeting at 2:50 p.m.
