S.C.R. 16: Directs board of regents of Unviersity of Nevada System to extend certain privileges to Viet Nam veterans.

Senator Foley read to the committee members the amendment by Senator Swobe. Following the reading of amendment, Senator Bryan moved "Do Pass" as amended, carried unanimously.

A.B. 469:

Mr. John Gamble, State Dept. of Education, stated that this bill removes the accrediting of classes in private schools and puts requirements for accrediting into licensing of private schools. Before a school can be licensed, the classes must be of the same quality that was formerly in the accrediting provisions.

Senator Foley stated that action on <u>A.B. 469</u> would be taken at the Senate Education Committee meeting to be held on Thursday, April 12, 1973. Also on April 12, 1973 will be a hearing on the law school.

Senator Foley adjourned the meeting at 3:50 p.m.
