MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Bremner, Messrs Price, Weise, Heaney, and Jacobsen

MEMBERS ABSENT: Messrs Chaney, Banner, Coulter and Jeffrey

Chairman Bremner called the meeting to order at 2:15 p.m. Mr. Weise moved a "DO PASS" recommendation on AJR 20; Mr. Weise seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

Mr. Weise moved a "DO PASS" recommendation on AJR 17; Mr. Price seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

Mr. Weise moved a "DO PASS" recommendation on SCR 8. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed.

Mr. Weise moved to amend AB 480 as suggested by the Associated General Contractors. The motion was seconded by Mr. Price. The motion to amend <u>AB 480</u> was unanimously passed.

Mr. Weise moved to recommend a "DO PASS"/on AB 480. The motion was seconded by Mr. Price. Mr. Heaney, under discussion, wanted the committee to be aware of a case considered by the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals, State of Arizona vs. Environmental Protection Agency, Case no. 74-1001, 1002, 1009, 1013, 73-3577, 73-3588, which questions whether the EPA can, under the authority of the Federal statute, 42 USC Sec 1857, impose restrictions on indirect sources of air pollution in the absence of evidence demonstrating that the restrictions on direct sources will fail to achieve and maintain ambient air quality standards. The motion to pass AB 480 was unanimously approved.

Chairman Bremner stated that <u>AB 620</u> will be held pending receipt of amendments from Mr. Dini.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
