(The following bill was discussed at this meeting: A.B. 258).

Chairman Dini called the meeting to order.

Chairman Dini stated that while the committee was waiting for Mr. Mirabelli and his staff, that Mr. Schofield would testify with regard to A.B. 258, which clarifies use of land descriptions by reference to certain maps in possession of county officers.

Mr. Schofield stated that the reason for holding this bill up was that there was a question on the legality and constitutionality of it and he had obtained a legal opinion from Mr. Burnett that there was no question about the constitutionality in regard to the Supreme Court cases that were cited.

Mr. Schofield stated that it would be a savings to the various counties over the period of a year.

Mr. Schofield stated that he had spoken with Mr. Galloway's office.

Mr. Dini asked what the advantage of it was and Mr. Schofield stated that possibility of error in not only advertising, but in the various tax sales and situations, that the treasurer is involved in that there has been a problem that an error may be found coming out of the meets and bounds descriptions. He stated that this bill would eliminate that possibility of error plus it would simplify matters also as far as notifying people on the tax bill. Mr. Schofield stated that it was more of a simplification for the citizens themselves. It would make it a little easier for the treasurer to advertise and use the

parcel number.

Mr. Schofield presented a copy of the amendment to the committee members, which amendment is <u>attached</u> to the Minutes of this Meeting and made a part hereof.

Mr. Moody made a motion for an "amend and do pass", which was seconded by Mr. Harmon. All of the committee members were in favor of the amend and do pass motion and it was unanimously carried.

The committee then stood in recess to wait for Mr. Mirabelli.

Mr. Dini stated that he did not want to keep the committee members, so that they would adjourn the meeting and speak to Mr. Mirabelli at another time.
