The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bennett for the purpose of discussing AB-146.

Phyllis Hansen, Legislative Representative of Nevada Nurses Assn., read a prepared statement in behalf of the bill. A copy of Ms. Hansen's statement is <u>attached</u> hereto. The last paragraph of the statement is requested as an amendment to the bill.

Jean Peavy of the State Board of Nursing also appeared to discuss <u>AB-146</u>. She stated the bill was requested because of a recommendation by the Attorney General's office. Upon questioning by Mr. Barengo, Ms. Peavy stated she did not know whether <u>AB-146</u> would solve their problem or not. Mr. Barengo suggested that Ms. Peavy contact Deputy Attorney General Elliot Sattler and suggest he write a letter to the Committee outlining his reasons for requesting this bill.

<u>SB-248</u> was next discussed by George Bennett, Secretary, State Board of Pharmacy. This bill increases the maximum fees that the Board may charge. The fees have not been increased since 1953, and inflation, increased inspections, continuing education of pharmacists, and checking posted prescription prices will all take more money. The Board is supported entirely by the fees collected. They need a full time inspector in Las Vegas now. If they do not get the increase they will have to decrease their services.

John Gimble said he could speak for <u>SB-8</u> as the bill was selfexplanatory. He urged a unanimous do pass.

Mr. Lowman presented a bill relating to the interstate placement of children and enacting the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children which he wished the Committee to introduce. The Committee voted unanimously to introduce the bill.

(b) Room, including a lecture or concert hall, in a public building while a public meeting is in progress in such room."

SUBJECT: AB-146 and Addition

I am here to speak in behalf of AB-146 which extends the period for hearing on disciplinary action brought against nurses.

The purpose of this extention is to allow the Board of Mursing time to confer with legal council and investigate a complaint before a hearing is heard. The present wording would allow only 30 days after the filing of a complaint for such action.

The power of the Board of Nursing to invoke disciplinary action is a very important function, especially with the extended and expanded role of nursing, and we believe that this change will allow sufficient time for appropriate investigation to be continued.

We urge a do pass on this bill.

In addition, we would like to increase compensation to nursing board members to the sum of one hundred dollars for each day spent by each member in the discharge of his official duties.
