The meeting was called to order at 9:40 A.M. by Chairman Banner for the purpose of discussing A.B. 386.

Chairman Banner asked Mr. Ray Bohart if he would like to speak on A.B. 386 for about 15 minutes, and explain the bill. Mr. Bohart declined to comment on the bill.

The first speaker in favor of the bill was Mr. Randy Webb, who was representing the Audit Division of the Legislative Council Bureau.

He explained that the purpose of A.B. 386 is to provide some technical amendments in statutes that already exist. First of all, to retitle the fund, and call it the Rehabilitation Gift Fund; to clarify some auditing procedures; and to specify exactly what this fund is for; to indicate clearly in the title of the fund itself, what the monies involved should be used for. Also, in Lines 11 thru 14, this is an effort on the part of the Audit Division, where we are reaching into statutes, and indicating the methods of accounting to be used in accounting for the funds so that it will be no problem as to how the funds are to be accounted for.

Mr. Benkovich asked whether the Rehabilitation fund is used mostly in Reno and Las Vegas, and for a further explanation of the fund.

Mr. Webb explains that the establishment of this fund is to provide the legislative means for monies given to the fund, such as grants, monies left by people, etc., to be put into a fund, where it would be used as the donors intended, and not into the general fund.

As there was no one else wishing to speak on A.B. 386, Mrs. Hayes moved that A.B. 386 be given a "do pass" recommendation. Mr. Barengo seconded the motion.

All members present voted "aye"

Mr. Moody moved that the meeting be adjourned.

Mr. Benkovich seconded the motion
