Chairman Glover called the meeting to order at 4:40 p.m.
The first bill discussed was:

S.B. 321 Abolished the advisory board to the board of
directors of the department of highways

Grant Bastian, Highway Dept, told the committee that it was suggested by one of the legislative auditors to either activate or repeal the Board. They have only met about twice in past 16 years and there is now no need for it, because the current Federal requirements in regard to the development and adoption of the localized transportation plants is that these have to be done in conjunction with local elected officials.

The next bill discussed was:

S.B. 384 Designates State Route 17 as Comstock Highway

Grant Bastian told the Committee his dept had no feelings either way on this bill. He was a little concerned with how far the naming of highways will go. He stated he had been asked for a fiscal note which he found would cost about \$500.00.

Chairman Glover announced that he had an amendment to the bill requested by Virgil Bucchianeri, District Attorney for Storey County. (see attached)

The next bill discussed was:

S.B. 295 Substitutes multiple trip-limited time permit for
annual or continuous permit to operate or move certain
vehicles

Grant Bastian stated this bill would add to the terminology in the existing statutes. Instead of annual permits and continuous permits it includes the terminology of multiple limited time permits. They (highway Dept) do not want to leave the conotation with the permittees that they have a permit that will remain

in effect a full year or forever. What this bill does is provide a multiple trip-limited time permit that may run for 6 months or maybe an annual permit but will still be open for renewal anytime the committee desires.

Chairman Glover announced that A.B. 490 on the agenda for today would not be heard until Thursday, April 17, when Howard Hill could be present to testify. He said there were amendments to the bill.

The following action was taken:

- S.B. 321 Mr. Dini made a motion for Do Pass, Mr. Howard seconded and it was unanimous. Chairman Glover asked Mrs. Hayes to speak on the bill.
- S.B. 384 Mr. Dini made a motion to amend and do pass; Mr. Howard seconded, and it was unanimous. Chairman Glover asked Mr. Dini to speak on the bill.
- S.B. 295 Mr. Howard made a motion for Do Pass; Mr. Dini seconded and it was unanimous. Mr. Howard was assigned to speak on this bill.

As there was no other business, Chairman Glover adjourned the meeting at 5:00 p.m.
