Special Meeting Assembly Transportation Committee April 17, 1975

A special meeting of the Assembly Transportation Committee was held on the Assembly floor at 11:30 A.M. Thursday, April 17, 1975. The bill discussed was:

A.B. 355 Changes designation from "State Assemblyman" to "State Assembly" on special license plate issued assemblyman.

Mr. Dreyer moved to indefinitely postpone the bill; Mr. Howard seconded, and the motion was unaminous with Glover and Hayes voting No.

S.B. 217 Requires that driver's license bear a colored photograph of the licensee and increases license fees.

The Committee agreed to have an amendment drawn to reduce the duplicate fee back to \$1.00. Page 2 line 14 by bracketing out (\$5.00) and inserting \$1.00. The Committee also decided for permissive language on page 1, line 9 and 10 for not only a profile view of a person under 21 and/or a colored backdrop to be used.

Mr. Dreyer moved amend and Do Pass; Mr. Howard seconded, and it was unaminous.
