
A short meeting was held on the floor of the Senate to vote on A.B. 800.

Declared an emergency measure

SUMMARY—Amends chapter 423, Statutes of Nevada 1975. Fiscal Note:
No. (BDR 52-2104)EXPLANATION—Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [] is
material to be omitted.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; limiting vertical competition in the distribution and marketing of alcoholic beverages; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto," approved May 13, 1975.

The People of the State of Nevada, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of the above-entitled act, being chapter 423,
2 Statutes of Nevada 1975, is hereby amended to read as follows:
3 Section 4. 1. A person engaged in the business of manufacturing,
4 blending or bottling of alcoholic beverages shall not engage in the busi-
5 ness of importing, wholesaling or retailing of alcoholic beverages by
6 investment, loan or extension of credit in excess of normal terms prevalent
7 in the industry [], *unless such person was so engaged on or before May*
8 *1, 1975, and then only to the extent so engaged.*
9 2. This section does not preclude any person engaged in the business
10 of importing, wholesaling or retailing alcoholic beverages from owning less
11 than 2 percent of the outstanding ownership equity in any organization
12 which manufactures, blends or bottles alcoholic beverages.
13 SEC. 2. This act shall become effective at 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 1975.
