

ADC - "MOTHER AND THREE CHILDREN"

Mrs. Maya Miller spoke and said that this system is an impossible combination of Federal, State and County regulations. Mrs. Miller said that with the Medical Benefit section assumes that the average costs per month of medical expenses per family is \$31 per person, however, this average is based on on very high medical costs. Mrs. Ruby Duncan said that if a family does not use these benefits, then this also affects the average. Senator Brown stated that it appeared their point was that not all the people are receiving this amount.

Mrs. Miller said that on the Housing Allotment of Food Stamp Bonus, the figures on rent and utilities are also assumed. Senator Gibson said are the figures based on the assumption that there is not any take-home pay. Mrs. Miller said that for the 70% and 100% support areas, the amount given is \$230.00. Mrs. Miller said that this is for Food Stamps (\$25.00), Shelter (\$195.00), and \$10.00 left for other expenses (in the 70% support area). Mrs. Miller also said that there is no "future" in this budget, as no social security or pension is planned for in the allotments.

Senator Raggio asked how many people were in the 100% support catagory. Mrs. Miller said that she did not know the numbers. Mrs. Duncan said that four out of five families currently receive the allotment for the no-income status, or 20% have a earned income.
