The meeting was called to order at 9:40 a.m. Senator Close was in the Chair.

Discussion on legislation involved with E.R.A.* Items discussed and recommendations:

- 125.150 - Alimony should be mutual and modifiable according to need, ability to pay, and child-rearing responsibilities. Senator Close directed Jim Kosinski to draft this.
- 125.160 - Omit. Will be incorporated with 125.150.
- 125.170 - Omit. Will be incorporated with 125.150.
- 125.180 - Amend to make reciprocal.
- 125.190 - Legal separation. No change at present. Hold for further discussion.
- 125.200 - 125.280 - Legal separation. No change at present. Hold for further discussion.
- 125.320 - Section 125.320 as amended in 1973 was distributed by Jim Kosinski. Mr. Kosinski then referred the committee's discussion to NRS 122.020. Subsection 2 of 125.320 was amended to make it reciprocal.
- 125.440 - Senator Dodge moved that this section be omitted.
- 126.030 - 126.370 - Senator Dodge moved that the committee refer this chapter to Jim Kosinski for further action.
- 134.180 - No change at present. Senator Close referred this to Jim Kosinski for a definition of illegitimacy.
- 122.020 - Senator Sheerin moved that the following changes be made:
Consent of parent or guardian;
Under 16 years of age - court consent required
Under 18 years of age but over 16 years of age - parental consent required
Over 18 years of age - no consent required

122.020 - Changes were also made in the following subsections:
Subsection 2: Substitute "father, mother, or guardian"
for "father".
Subsection 3: Amend to read "whichever has custody".
Subsection 4: Amend to read "where one has been appointed".

122.025 - Delete.

End of discussion involved with E.R.A.


Senator Bryan presented the following 3 items for committee

BDR 16-561 Changes involving sexual crimes


Unanimously approved for introduction.
