Senator Close presented the following items for Committee introduction:

BDR 16-182 Requires preliminary inquiry following arrest of a parolee for alleged parole violation to determine if reasonable ground for revocation of parole exists.

Senator Hilbrecht moved for Committee introduction, Seconded by Senator Dodge, Motion carried unanimously.

BDR 38-152 Revises aid-to-dependent-children relative responsibility requirements and repeals relative responsibility provisions for adult categories of public assistance.

Senator Sheerin moved for Committee introduction, Seconded by Senator Hilbrecht, Motion carried unanimously.

BDR 11-378 Defines "age of majority" to include certain persons 16 or 17 years of age who have been declared emancipated by the court.

Senator Hilbrecht moved for Committee introduction, Seconded by Senator Bryan, Motion carried unanimously.
