MINUTES OF MEETING

FEBRUARY 3, 1975

422.310 - At the request of the Committee, Mr. Dale Landon, Mr. William LaBadie, and Mr. Robert Holland from the State Welfare Office were present to give testimony on this section.

After considerable discussion, Senator Close recommended that the section be retained as is for the time being. However, he suggested that they introduce a bill which would remove this from Chapter 422 and replace it in Chapter 425 (Aid to Dependent Children) and rewrite it so that it applies to the support of minor children by the parents. Recommendation approved unanimously by the Committee.

616.510 - At the request of the Committee, Mr. Jim Morgan from the Nevada Industrial Commission was present to give testimony on this section. Senator Close recommended this section be held for further discussion and requested that Mr. Morgan return at that time.

201.300 - 201.310 - 201.320 - 201.320 - 201.330 - 201.340 - 201.360 - Senator ~~Dodge~~ moved that these sections be incorporated into a single pandering statute. Seconded by Senator Hilbrecht. Motion carried unanimously. In addition to the redraft, Senator Hilbrecht recommended that Subsection 2 of Section 201.310 be amended to omit the phrase "with or without his consent, and may be compelled so to testify."
