Nevada Constitution - Article 4, Section 31 - Hold until discussion on community property.


Nevada Constitution - Article 15, Section 3 - Amend to read "No person shall be eligible to any office who is not a qualified elector under this constitution." (Beginning on Line 3 "No person who," delete through Line 16).

Following discussion of specific legislation that would be affected by E.R.A. there was a general discussion on community property laws. Senator Dodge suggested examining the community property laws and the changes made in them of other states. Senator Sheerin recommended hiring someone experienced in community property laws to research this and report back to the Committee. Senator Hilbrecht stated that he would like to have several people testify before the Committee. Senator Close informed the Committee that it was authorized to pay transportation costs and \$100.00 for guest speakers and that he would contact someone today to speak to them as soon as possible.

Senator Close informed the Committee that he had been requested to introduce the "Smokey Stover Bill". There was no Committee action taken at this time.
