Senator Close read to the Committee the amendments as drafted. The bill has been "do passed as amended" on March 10, 1975. There was no further action taken at this time.

The Committee has received a request for legislation dealing with a subsitute method for process service.

Senator Wilson stated that he felt the bill should be amended so that substitute service by mail could only be made upon affidavit that personal service could not be made.

Senator Bryan will research the California law on this and report back to the Committee.

No action was taken at this time.

Senator Wilson has received a request for a bill which would enable licensed and bonded process servers to process writs of execution. There was a brief discussion on the matter however, no action was taken at this time.

SB 319 Requires and provides for interpreters for certain handicapped persons in civil and criminal proceedings.

Senator Close read to the Committee the amendments as drafted by Frank Daykin.

There was a brief discussion on the matter however no action was taken at this time.

Senator Close presented the following items for Committee introduction:

BDR 7-806 Amends various provisions of take-over bid disclosure requirements relating to private corporations.

BDR 11-709 Provides emancipation of certified minors.

The Committee approved introduction unanimously.
