ACTION WAS THEN TAKEN ON THE FOLLOWING BILLS:

<u>SB 119</u> Increases fees, changes notification requirements and makes other revisions in Nevada Boat Act. *

Mr. Parsons and Mr. Griffith of the Nevada Fish and Game Department testified as to the purpose of the bill and explained changes that had been proposed for amendment. After thorough discussion of all amendments throughout the bill, Senator Herr asked that the committee wait until later in the meeting for a vote on the measure.

<u>SB 131</u> <u>Allows use of certain moneys for administration and</u> enforcement of Nevada Boat Act. *

> Mr. Parsons and Mr. Griffith testified as to the purpose of the bill. They did have an amendment to the bill which was: Section 1, Sub-section 3, to delete (d) and insert instead: Any expenses which may be necessary for the administration and enforcement of Chapter 488 of NRS (Nevada Boat Act) in an amount equal to the interest derived from moneys received pursuant to NRS 365.535, 488.075 and 488.1793.

Senator Herr requested that they submit a statement explaining what NRS 365.535, 488.075 and 488.1793 pertain to, so that the Committee members would have this information when the bill came to the floor of the Senate for vote. Senator Neal moved <u>DO PASS WITH AMENDMENT</u>. Senator Raggio seconded the motion Motion carried unanimously.

SB 119 (Continued)

Senator Herr asked if anyone had a motion regarding SB 119. It was decided that each amendment would be voted upon separately.

Senator Raggio moved that in Section 7, Subsection 2 (Page 3) line 27, and Subsection 14, (Page 5), lines 19 through 22, be amended by deleting brackets and bill would read as it presently does. Senator Monroe seconded the motion. All voted aye except Senator Gojack who voted nay.

Senator Raggio moved that Section 8, Subsection 2 (Page 5) lines 36 and 37, be amended by deleting brackets and bill would read as it presently does. Senator Schofield seconded the motion. All voted nay except Senator Raggio and Senator Schofield.

Senator Raggio moved that all brackets be removed from Sections 9 and 10 and bill would read as it presently does. Senator Monroe seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimous.

Senator Neal then moved <u>DO PASS WITH A-MENDMENTS</u>. Senator Monroe seconded the motion. All voted aye with the exception of Senator Raggio who voted nay.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned until Wednesday, February 26, 1975 at 12:00 noon.

SUMMARY-Increases fees, changes notification requirements and makes other revisions in Nevada Boat Act. Fiscal Note: No. (BDR 43-257)

EXPLANATION—Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the Nevada Boat Act; increasing fees charged for certificates; changing time allowed for notification of ownership change; requiring fire extinguishers on racing boats; requiring observer when vessel is towing water skier on any waters and restricting towing hours; eliminating sheriffs and peace officers other than game wardens as enforcers of the Nevada Boat Act; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

The People of the State of Nevada, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. NRS 488.075 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 488.075 1. The owner of each motorboat requiring numbering by this state shall file an application for number and for a certificate of 3 4 ownership with the department on forms approved by it accompanied by proof of payment of Nevada sales or use tax as evidenced by proof of sale by a Nevada dealer or by a certificate of use tax paid issued by the Nevada tax commission, or by proof of exemption from such taxes as provided in NRS 372.320, and by such evidence of ownership as the department may require. The department shall not issue a number, a 10 certificate of number or a certificate of ownership until such evidence is 11 presented to it.

12 2. The application shall be signed by the owner of the motorboat 13 and shall be accompanied by a fee of [\$3] \$5 for the certificate of num-14 ber and a fee of [\$3] \$5 for the certificate of ownership. All fees received 15 by the department under the provisions of this chapter shall be deposited 16 in the fish and game fund and shall be expended only for the admin-17 istration and enforcement of the provisions of this chapter. Upon receipt 18 of the application in approved form, the department shall:

19 (a) Enter the same upon the records of its office and issue to the applicant a certificate of number stating the number awarded to the 20 motorboat, a certificate of ownership stating the same information and 21 22 the name and address of the registered owner and the legal owner.

SECTION 1. NRS 501.358 is hereby amended to read as follows:

501.358 1. The fish and game reserve fund is hereby created. Such fund shall consist of the interest paid on deposits made pursuant to the provisions of subsection 2 of NRS 501.356, which interest shall be transferred annually between June 1 and July 31 to the fish and game reserve fund until such fund totals \$150,000, and thereafter as may be necessary to maintain the reserve fund at \$150,000. The interest paid on such deposits above the amount necessary to maintain the reserve fund at \$150,000 shall be transferred annually between June 1 and July 31 to the fish and game fund.

2. The moneys in the fish and game reserve fund shall be deposited at interest, with the written approval of the state board of finance, in any state or national bank or banks or savings associations in the State of Nevada.

3. Moneys in the fish and game reserve fund may be expended at such times and in such amounts as may be necessary for:

(a) The acquisition of lands, water rights, easements and other property to be used for wildlife management.

(b) Any expenses which may be necessary for the propagation, protection, restoration, introduction and transplanting of wildlife in or into this state.

(c) The financing of any emergency measures which may be necessary for the protection, management and propagation of wildlife in this state.
