ASSEMBLY BILL 32

Mr. Dini told the committee that he felt the requirement of real property ownership to qualify to vote or hold office in county fire protection districts was unfair and probably unconstitutional. He urged a recommendation of DO PASS from the committee.

ASSEMBLY BILL 51

Mr. John Crossley of the Audit Division of the Legislative Counsel presented testimony regard this bill. He explained that this legislation was requested by the Audit Division to simplify and clarify the accounting procedure for capital construction projects.
