Chairman Glover called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m.

After discussion the committee decided to talk with public works, the leadership and members of the press and then make a decision at a brief meeting at Chairman Glover's desk.

<u>SB 215</u>: Provides for payment of travel expenses and subsistence allowances for secretary of senate.


After discussion of the secretary's salary, amending to add the Chief Clerk of the Assembly if not a resident of the area, and the cost of daily living in Carson City, Mrs. Brookman moved a DO PASS on <u>SB 215</u>, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion was carried with Mrs. Brookman, Mr. Bennett, Mr. Coulter, Mr. Murphy, Mrs. Wagner and Chairman Glover voting yes and Mr. Bremner, no vote. Mr. Bremner stated that he would try to amend out the retroactive portion of the bill on the floor.

Mrs. Wagner suggested that there be a spectrum of opinions represented on this committee. Mr. Bremner stated that he had talked with the introducer of this bill who no longer feels this bill is necessary as there is an almost identical bill that has passed the Senate. The committee decided to hold the bill until discussion with the introducer.
