Chairman Glover called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m.

Mr. Murphy requested that, since a new taping system was going to be installed at the Chief Clerk's desk in the Assembly, an additional wire be extended to the press table with jacks for tape recorders so the press could tape individual speeches of the legislators or the entire proceedings. After discussion the committee decided to talk with public works, the leadership and members of the press and then make a decision at a brief meeting at Chairman Glover's desk.

SB 215: Provides for payment of travel expenses and subsistence allowances for secretary of senate.

After discussion of the secretary's salary, amending to add the Chief Clerk of the Assembly if not a resident of the area, and the cost of daily living in Carson City, Mrs. Brookman moved a DO PASS on SB 215, seconded by Mr. Murphy. The motion was carried with Mrs. Brookman, Mr. Bennett, Mr. Coulter, Mr. Murphy, Mrs. Wagner and Chairman Glover voting yes and Mr. Bremner, no vote. Mr. Bremner stated that he would try to amend out the retroactive portion of the bill on the floor.

ACR 12: Creates select committee on public lands.



Mr. Bremner stated that he had talked with the introducer of this bill who no longer feels this bill is necessary as there is an almost identical bill that has passed the Senate. The committee decided to hold the bill until discussion with the introducer.

AB 200: Enlarges legislative control of its buildings and grounds.

Mrs. Brookman asked Chairman Glover if the committee could take action on this bill. Mr. Glover stated that he had some amendments that were waiting to be typed before action could be taken.
