S.B. 474 ADDS CERTAIN VEHICLES TO MOBILE HOME STANDARDS ACT
AND REMOVES ENFORCEMENT FROM STATE FIRE MARSHALL
DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE. (BDR 43-1566)

Motion to amend and DO PASS by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Seconded by SENATOR BRYAN.
Vote: All in favor, except SENATOR YOUNG who
abstained.

Amendments to include the elimination of RV's in Section 8 and incorporate the amendments offered by Mr. Hoy.

A.B. 426 REQUIRES TEMPERATURE-CORRECTED QUANTITIES OF GASOLINE
TO BE BILLED TO SERVICE STATIONS. (BDR 52-1386)

Committee decided to hold.

S.B. 479 PROVIDES FOR REGULATION OF RETAIL SALE OF CONVENIENCE
DRUGS. (BDR 54-1711)

Motion for indefinite postponement by SENATOR ASHWORTH.
Seconded by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Vote: All in favor of KILL except Senator Bryan and
Senator Young abstained.

S.B. 474 ADDS CERTAIN VEHICLES TO MOBILE HOME STANDARDS ACT
AND REMOVES ENFORCEMENT FROM STATE FIRE MARSHAL
DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE. (BDR 43-1566)

Committee examined amendments furnished to the

S.B. 480 AMENDS PHARMACY LAW CONCERNING ADMINISTRATIVE PRO-
CEEDINGS AND EXPENSES OF MEMBERS OF STATE BOARD OF
PHARMACY; PROPOSES AMENDMENTS FOR OPERATION OF
PHARMACIES AND PRESCRIPTIONS FOR DANGEROUS DRUGS.
(BDR 54-1655)

SENATOR ASHWORTH moved to DO PASS.
Seconded by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Vote: Senator Close voted no. Senator Young
abstained. Balance of Committee voted for
DO PASS.

S.B. 477 REGULATES FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS OF REAL ESTATE BROKERS.
(BDR 54-1736)

SENATOR YOUNG moved to indefinitely postpone.
Seconded by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Vote: Unanimous.

S.B. 492 RESTRICTS DEDUCTION FROM DISABILITY INSURANCE BENEFITS
FOR OTHER DISABILITY INCOME. (BDR 57-1799)

SENATOR HERNSTADT moved to indefinitely postpone.
Seconded by SENATOR ASHWORTH.
Vote: All in favor of indefinite postponement except
Senators Wilson and Bryan. Senator Young
abstained.

S.B. 471 CHANGES CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE AND ACCOUNTING PRO-
CEDURES OF INSURANCE DIVISION OF DEPARTMENT OF
COMMERCE. (BDR 57-1704)

Motion to DO PASS by SENATOR YOUNG.
Seconded by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Vote: Unanimous

S.B. 475 CLASSIFIES REAL ESTATE BROKERS AND SALESMEN FOR
PURPOSES OF INDUSTRIAL INSURANCE AND OCCUPATIONAL
DISEASE COVERAGE. (BDR 54-1735)

SENATOR YOUNG moved to amend and DO PASS.
Seconded by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Vote: Unanimous.

Senator Wilson to check amendments submitted by
Messrs. Cozart and Reiser to make sure there are
no substantive changes.

S.B. 478 PROHIBITS USE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES OF CERTAIN
TERMS IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE. (BDR 54-1514)

SENATOR YOUNG moved to KILL.
Seconded by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Vote: Unanimous.

S.B. 483 MAKES VEHICLE LESSEE'S INSURANCE PRIMARY IN ACCI-
DENTS CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE OR MISCONDUCT OF LESSEE.
(BDR 43-1659)

SENATOR YOUNG moved to KILL.
Seconded by SENATOR HERNSTADT.
Vote: Unanimous.

A.B. 407 AMENDS VARIOUS PROVISIONS RELATING TO ADMINISTRA-
TION OF UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION. (BDR 53-871)

SENATOR ASHWORTH moved to amend and DO PASS.
Seconded by SENATOR BRYAN.
Vote: Unanimous.


Amendment to include amendment furnished by Mr.


line 34 "IN LIEU OF NOTICE and the balance". Put
