S.B. 518 AUTHORIZES PHYSICIANS TO PERFORM CERTAIN ACTS WITH

WITHOUT HOLDING CERTIFICATES, LICENSE, OR PERMIT
ISSUED BY BOARD OF PHARMACY. (BDR 54-1508)

Vote: All in favor except SENATOR ASHWORTH who was
absent, SENATOR YOUNG who abstained and SENATOR
HERNSTADT who voted no.

DRUGS. (BDR 54-1711)

Motion to amend and DO PASS by SENATOR BRYAN.

Seconded by SENATOR BLAKEMORE.

Vote in favor: SENATORS BRYAN, BLAKEMORE and WILSON.
SENATOR YOUNG abstained and SENATOR
ASHWORTH was absent.

Vote against: SENATORS CLOSE and HERNSTADT.


was too late in the Session to process the bill.
