Chairman Vergiels called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. He explained that this meeting had been called to act on bills previously heard by the Committee, and that amendments to some of the bills would be considered. He called on Assemblyman Horn to explain the amendments proposed to Assembly Bill 38.

ASSEMBLY BILL 38

Assemblyman Horn went through the amendments to A.B. 38, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked Exhibit A. It was decided to also delete on lines 5 and 6 the words "and other tests".

It was moved by Mrs. Wagner and seconded by Mrs. Westall that the amendments be adopted. The motion was carried with Mr. Webb voting "No".

It was moved by Mr. Malone and seconded by Mrs. Westall that A.B. 38 be recommended Do Pass as Amended. The motion was carried with Mr. Webb voting "No".

ASSEMBLY BILL 91

Assemblyman Horn went through the proposed amendments to A.B. 91, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked Exhibit B. The purpose of the bill was to provide a model disciplinary code to schools which did not have an all inclusive one of their own.

It was moved by Mr. Banner and seconded by Mr. Craddock that the amendments be adopted. The motion was carried unanimously.

It was moved by Mr. Banner and seconded by Mr. Craddock that A.B. 91 be recommended Do Pass as Amended. The motion was defeated with Mr. Stewart, Mrs. Wagner, Mr. Webb, Mr. Malone and Mrs. Hayes voting "No".

ASSEMBLY BILL 248

Following a lengthy discussion and debate, it was decided to have further study on A.B. 248.

ASSEMBLY BILL 121

Following a presentation by Dr. Bryan and Dr. Ryan of the State Board of Education, it was moved by Mrs. Wagner and seconded by Mr. Craddock that A.B. 121 be recommended Do Pass and Re-Refer to the Committee on Ways and Means. The motion carried with Mr. Banner and Mr. Webb not voting.

ASSEMBLY BILL 388

Joyce Woodhouse explained the proposed amendments to A.B. 388. Following discussion, Mrs. Westall moved that the amendments be accepted, seconded by Mr. Banner. The motion carried unanimously.


Mrs. Westall moved Do Pass as Amended, seconded by Mr. Banner. The motion was carried with Mr. Webb and Mr. Stewart voting "No".

It was further moved by Mrs. Wagner, seconded by Mrs. Hayes, that an amendment be added to A.B. 388 containing a sunset or termination clause. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Webb read a proposed resolution received from California which would memorialize the President and Congress of the United States to undertake such actions as may be necessary to insure that the Federal Government reimburses each state for all costs incurred with respect to input implementing new programs or providing increased levels of service under existing programs pursuant to any law enacted by Congress after January 1, 1980, or any executive order or regulation issued by the president after January 1, 1980. This would make it so there would be no state funds involved if a new federal program comes along. Mr. Webb would like to add to this the fact that we would like to have the opportunity, as a state, to refuse any new program and have an option on any new program. He asked if there was any objection to his having this drafted as a committee introduction. There was no objection.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:30 p.m. by Chairman Vergiels.
