Chairman Banner called the meeting to order at 3:04 p.m.
He called for testimony on S.B. 350.

S.B. 350 - Provides penalty for failure of producer-promoter
of entertainment production to obtain permit and
post bond with labor commissioner.

Mark Tully Massagli, Nevada State AFL-CIO president,
testified in favor of S.B. 350. He is also president of the
Musicians Union in Las Vegas. He explained that the Legislature in 197
passed NRS 608.300 to 320, pertaining to licensing of independent
producers and promoters. The problem has been that there is no
way to enforce NRS 608 because there was no penalty for not
complying with the law. The law was granted in such a way that
people in bonafide business and the hotels would be absolved
from having to comply with the law. He said anybody can come
into the state, get in touch with an entertainment director,
posts notices and ads. And when he is out of work this person
just folds up and leaves. If a person goes to the labor
commissioner saying there is an independent producer that is
advertising in local papers for musicians, dancers, and have no
firm commitment to pay for these people, the labor commissioner
just walks away because there is no penalty involved. He said
S.B. 350 would meet the need for protection if the penalty was
there. He urged passage of S.B. 350.

Chairman Banner asked Mr. Massagli if he knew of any
objections to the bill when it was heard in the Senate. Mr.
Massagli replied he didn't know of any, that the Senate Committee
passed it 19-0.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

Senate Bill 350: Mr. Robinson moved Do Pass, seconded by Mr. Bremner. Motion carried unanimously, with Mr. Jeffrey not present.

Assembly Bill 564: Mr. Robinson moved Do Pass, seconded by Mr. Bremner. Motion carried, with Mr. Webb voting No, and Mr. Jeffrey not present.

A.B. 241: Mr. Webb moved Do Pass, seconded by Mr. Rhoads. Motion carried, with Mr. Banner voting No.

A.B. 238: Mr. Robinson moved Indefinite Postponement, seconded by Mr. Bennett. Motion carried.

A.B. 240: Mr. Robinson moved Indefinite Postponement As Amended, seconded by Mr. Jeffrey. Motion carried.

A.B. 239: Motion made by Mr. Jeffrey for Indefinite Postponement, seconded by Mr. Bennett. Motion carried. Ayes: Messrs. Bremner, Robinson, Jeffrey, Banner and Bennett. Voting NO were: Messrs. Brady, Webb and Rhoads.

A.B. 242: Mr. Bennett moved Indefinite Postponement, seconded by Mr. Jeffrey. Motion carried. Ayes: Messrs. Robinson, Bennett, Banner, Jeffrey and Fielding. No votes: Rhoads, Webb, Brady and Bremner.

A.B. 203: Mr. Bremner moved Do Pass as Amended, seconded by Mr. Webb. Amendment to read 55% instead of 65%, on line 5, Motion carried. Ayes: Messrs. Bremner, Webb, Robinson, Rhoads and Fielding. No votes: Messrs. Jeffrey, Banner, Bennett & Brady.

A.B. 243: Moved by Mr. Jeffrey for Indefinite Postponement, seconded by Mr. Bennett. Motion passed unanimously.

A.J.R. 22: Mr. Jeffrey moved for Indefinite Postponement, seconded by Mr. Bennett. Motion carried. Ayes: Messrs. Bremner, Bennett, Banner, Jeffrey and Fielding. No votes: Brady, Robinson, Rhoads and Webb.

A.B. 489: Mr. Jeffrey moved Do Pass as Amended, seconded by Mr. Robinson. The amendment will leave out everything in the bill, except for provision that funeral benefits be raised to \$2,500. This is Sec. 2 of NRS 616.615, Item 1. on page 3, line 17. Motion passed unanimously.
