Chairman Sena called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. The first matter discussed was

A.B. 775 - Adds positive requirement that taxicab administrator investigate background of applicants for permits as cab drivers.

Mr. Jim Avance, Administrator, Nevada Taxicab Authority, explained that in January the state had received a letter from the Federal Bureau of Investigation advising that fingerprint cards relating to applicants for taxi service, among others, would no longer be processed. A copy of the FBI's letter is attached as Exhibit A. Mr. Avance further said that A.B. 775 was being amended to include the wording, "The agency will conduct a check through the State of Nevada and the FBI fingerprint system." This is to be included in the event Public Law 92-544 is changed.

A.B. 771 - Limits use of studded tires to conform to laws of adjacent states.

Mr. Joe Souza, State Highway Engineer, said this is merely a change in the month from September to October in which the use of studded tires is permitted to conform to Oregon and California dates.

Chairman Sena requested that Mr. Daykin further explain the amendments to S.B. 335. Mr. Daykin said he believed these

amendments go as far as effectively possible toward meeting Senator McCorkle's objections to the bill without a Constitutional amendment. Mr. Daykin further stated that Senator Blakemore and Senator Dodge concurred with these amendments as far as he was aware.

Mr. Bob Guinn explained the amendments to A.B. 67 as contained in the reprint. There was a typographical error found in Line 41, page 2; the word "be" should be "by".

S.B. 360 - Mr. Glover moved Do Pass. Seconded by Mr. Polish and carried. Mrs. Westall, Mrs. Hayes and Mr. FitzPatrick absent.

A.B. 592 - Mr. Glover moved Indefinitely Postpone. Seconded by Mr. Stewart and carried. Mr. Polish voted no. Mrs. Westall, Mrs. Hayes and Mr. FitzPatrick absent.

A.B. 651 - Mr. Glover moved Indefinitely Postpone. Seconded by Mr. Stewart and carried. Mrs. Westall, Mrs. Hayes and Mr. FitzPatrick absent.

S.B. 335 - Mr. Glover moved Do Pass as Amended. Seconded by Mr. Polish and carried. Mrs. Westall, Mrs. Hayes and Mr. FitzPatrick absent.

A.B. 751 - Mr. Prengaman moved Indefinitely Postpone. Seconded by Mr. Stewart and carried. Mrs. Wagner abstained. Mrs. Westall, Mrs. Hayes and Mr. FitzPatrick absent.

S.B. 349 - Allows operator of tow car to make cash deposit in lieu of insurance or bond to cover vehicle being towed.

Senator Blakemore said this bill would allow operators of small tow cars to deposit money or a savings certificate in lieu of maintaining a policy of cargo insurance or bond to cover a vehicle being towed. He cited the example of a small tow car operator in Goldfield whose insurance premium for the cargo insurance was more than he earned during the year.

Mr. John Walley, Public Service Commission, said the PSC endorses this bill.

S.B. 455 - Provides for special permits to operate vehicles exceeding legal maximum width on highways during weekends and holidays.

Senator Blakemore said this bill is to allow construction companies or other vehicles to be granted special permits to operate vehicles exceeding the legal maximum width on weekends and holidays as they are allowed to do on weekdays. These permits must be obtained from the Highway Department and may be issued at its discretion.

In response to Mrs. Wagner's question, Senator Blakemore said these weekend permits would extend only to 10 foot wide vehicles, not 12 or 14 foot wide vehicles who may obtain permits Monday through Friday. Any vehicles over 8 foot wide must have a permit to operate on the highway at any time.

Mr. Souza questioned lines 30 and 31 on page 4,.. "upon application in writing, issue a permit to operate a vehicle.." He would like this to specify a "single trip permit" since they also issue annual permits. Senator Blakemore said that specifying a single trip permit would be agreeable to him.

Mrs. Wagner expressed concern that Mr. Souza had stated that the majority of these special permits were granted as a matter of course. She felt the permits should only be granted after an evaluation and based upon need and necessity in order not to interfere with weekend traffic.

COMMITTEE ACTION

S.B. 349 - Mr. FitzPatrick moved Do Pass. Seconded by Mrs. Westall and carried. Mr. Stewart, Mr. Glover and Mrs. Hayes absent.

Reference my telephone call this date concerning the FBI's processing of certain applicant fingerprint cards from the State of Nevada.

A review of the pertinent Nevada laws authorizing criminal record checks for purposes of licensing and/or employment within the State of Nevada has been completed. It was determined that Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 244.335 is not sufficient to meet the standards imposed on the FBI by Public Law 92-544. Therefore, fingerprint cards relating to the following categories of employment and/or licensing can no longer be processed by the FBI as these categories are based upon NRS 244.335:

1. Auctioneers and their Clerks
2. Ambulance Drivers and Owners
3. Auto and Trailer Dealers
4. Auto Rental
5. Fortune Tellers

The authority (NRS 244.335) used as the basis for conducting criminal record checks for the aforementioned 14 categories of employment and/or licensing fails to meet the standards imposed by Public Law 92-544 since the U. S. Department of Justice (DOJ) has advised the FBI that administrative rules or regulations based upon general statutory authority cannot satisfy the standards. The DOJ has advised that the specific statute establishing the guidelines for a category of employment or the issuance of a license must, in itself, require fingerprinting or authorize the governmental licensing or employing
