ACR 13 Allocates certain proceeds of 1976 park bond issue for and authorizes purchase of land near Wildhorse Reservoir.

Glen Griffith, Director of Department of Fish and Game asked the Committee to approve this bill to purchase the land and to provide for camping facilities. Initial purchase price of the property was \$240,000, and now the price is estimated to be \$260,000.

Senator Glaser moved "Do Pass" ACR 13.

Seconded by Senator Wilson.

SB 208 Appropriation for perquisites for prison director.

Warden Wolff and Mike Medema testified for SB 208. Mr. Medema stated the appropriation is \$6,986 for the warden's perquisites which were removed by the last legislature in error.

Senator Gibson moved "Do Pass" SB 208.

Seconded by Senator Jacobsen.

Motion carried unanimously.

SB 218 Appropriation for payment of communications board assessment.

Senator Lamb read a proposal to adopt amendment for SB 218 by deleting the \$7,650. The bill was also amended to appropriate \$40,000 for emergency expenditures and for the creation of a working capital fund.

Senator Glaser moved "Do Pass as Amended" SB 218.

Seconded by Senator Jacobsen.

Motion carried unanimously.

Senator Gibson moved to concur with Assembly.

Seconded by Senator Wilson.

Motion carried unanimously.

AB 520 Corrects error in law concerning renewal of real estate license fees and provides credit or refund for excess payments.

Senator Wilson moved to approve the amendment to AB 520.


Seconded by Senator McCorkle.

Senator McCorkle abstained.


Motion carried.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 2

1. The real estate division of the department of commerce shall, upon the next renewal of a license by a real estate broker, broker-salesman, corporate broker or real estate salesman, credit to his account any amount of money paid by him for the biennial renewal of his license between July 1, 1977 and the effective date of this bill:

(a) In excess of \$80 in the case of a real estate broker, broker-salesman or corporate broker; or

(b) In excess of \$50 in the case of a real estate salesman.

2. If such a licensee does not renew his license, any amount which would otherwise be credited to his account pursuant to subsection 1 must be paid to him or a person authorized to accept the payment on his behalf.
