Chairman Gibson opened the sixteenth meeting of the Government Affairs committee at 11:15 a.m.

SB-251 Requires approval of local government advisory committee as prerequisite to adoption of certain regulations of division of archives.

Chairman Gibson read a letter sent to the committee from Mr. Sam Mamet, representing Clark County. (See Attachment #1) The Chairman indicated that if SB-84 passes the Assembly a letter should be sent to the State Librarian asking for cooperation in setting standards with the local government advisory committee rather than having a law set into the statutes.

Senator Ford suggested that this bill be tabled until the disposition of SB-84 is known.

Senator Ford moved to table SB-251 until final action on SB-84 is known  
Seconded by Senator Echols  
Motion carried unanimously.

AB-290 Provides for additional locations for the receipt of bids for state purchases.

Chairman Gibson stated that AB-290 removes Carson City and also adds language providing for a date, hour and location on proposals of bids for state purchases.

Senator Keith Ashworth moved "Do Pass" on AB-290  
Seconded by Senator Raggio  
Motion carried unanimously.

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

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

Dear Mr. Chairman:

This Friday afternoon your committee will be considering S.B. 251 which would require that any regulations proposed by the State Division of Archives must be submitted and approved by the local government advisory committee to the Nevada Department of Taxation. This committee was established pursuant to NRS 354.594. Reason for this legislation is to clearly establish the fact that this committee comprised of local government officials has some additional input into the adoption of these archive regulations since these very definitely affect local government in the disposition of records and documents.

This legislation was proposed by several local government officials who serve on the local government advisory committee because they were disturbed with some of the far-reaching regulations proposed by the State Archives Division on retention periods for local government records.

We respectfully ask that the committee give favorable consideration to this legislation.
