# SENATE COMMITTEE RULES

#### 'NATURAL RESOURCES COMMITTEE

### **60TH SESSION**

- Four members constitute a quorum of the committee.
- 2. Motions will be moved, seconded, and passed by a simple majority of those present, except that action ("DO PASS" or "INDEFINITELY POSTPONE") on a bill will require a majority of the entire committee.
- 3. In order to reconsider previous action taken on an indefinitely postponed bill, an affirmative vote of five members of the committee will be required.
- 4. Mason's Manual will be followed as to parliamentary procedure.
- 5. Any member of the committee may request an item on the agenda by contacting the committee chairman four days ahead of the committee meeting.
- 6. Committee bill introduction will be only by approval of five committee members. Committee introduction does not imply in any way a commitment on the part of any member to support the bill introduced.
- 7. Motions for "DO PASS" or "INDEFINITELY POSTPONE" will be taken only at the call of the chairman or in accordance with Rule No. 5 above. Such votes will be recorded by name in the minutes of the meeting.
