

SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

Minutes of Meeting
Thursday, January 18, 1979

The meeting was called to order in Room 323, Legislative Building, at 11:45 a.m. on Thursday, January 18, 1979.

The proposed committee rules were read by Chairman Blakemore and the following rules were adopted:

COMMITTEE RULES - 60TH SESSION
TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

1. Four members constitute a quorum of the committee.
2. Motions will be moved, seconded, and passed by a simple majority of those present, except that definite action (Do Pass or Hold) on a bill will require a majority of the entire committee.
3. In order to reconsider previous actions taken, an affirmative vote of five (5) members of the committee will be required. However, a majority present may allow the hearing of new evidence or information which would be pertinent to the determination of whether or not a matter or an action should be reconsidered.
4. Mason's Manual will be followed as to parliamentary procedure.
5. Any member of the committee may request an item on the agenda by contacting the committee chairman.
6. Committee bill introduction will be only by unanimous approval of the committee members present. Committee introduction does not imply in any way a commitment on the part of any committee member to support the bill introduced.
7. The Transportation Committee has an assigned meeting time of P.M. Adjournment in Room 323 and will meet at that time. Members are urged to plan their work so that they can be present at each meeting and can be available at the appointed hour.

3. A Minority Report must be requested at the time a bill or resolution is reported out of committee and the Minority Report to be filed with the Secretary of the Senate must be individually signed by each member requesting it.

Senator Faiss moved the rules be adopted.
Senator Jacobsen seconded the motion.
Motion carried unanimously.

Senator Jacobsen suggested that if any tours were to be made that they be done early.

Chairman Blakemore agreed and said he would get an appointment for one with the Department of Motor Vehicles for Tuesday, January 23, 1979.
