AB 654 MAKES CERTAIN CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES RELATED
TO PUBLIC HEALTH.

Richard Bettinck, Chief of the Bureau of Childrens Health Services
in the Health Division, said this bill was the result of a request
of the Legislative Auditors who cannot be here to testify until
their report is published. He said the bill is endorsed by the
State Health Officer. He said it is just to clear up verbage.

Assemblyman Ham said that it deletes 583 and 563 which creates
the main inspection working capital fund and creates a special
State Health Division federal fund.

Mr. Nicholas said that this includes so much technical information
that he would not vote on the bill until someone from Audit is
present.

AB 655 BROADENS PROVISIONS FOR STATE MEDICAL AID.

Motion by Mr. Mello TO REFER TO WAYS AND MEANS WITHOUT RECOMMENDATION,
seconded by Mr. Thompson. Motion carried unanimously.
