Provisions of AB 207, AB 292, and AB 296 will be incorporated
together into an amendment to AB 292 and will comply with
federal mandates. EXHIBIT A Pages 1 through 3 (attached to
these minutes).

Mr. Jeffrey moved AMEND AND DO PASS on AB 292, seconded by
Mr. Rhoads and carried unanimously by the members present,
with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote. (8-0).

AB 207: Provides exceptions for charging benefits paid as
unemployment compensation against employers.

AB 207 will be incorporated into AB 292.

Mr. Jeffrey moved to INDEFINITELY POSTPONE AB 207, seconded
by Mr. Thompson and carried unanimously by the members present,
with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote. (8-0).

AB 296: Revises certain conditions of eligibility for unemployment compensation.

AB 296 will be incorporated into AB 292.

Mr. Jeffrey moved to INDEFINITELY POSTPONE AB 296, seconded by Miss Foley and carried unanimously by the members present, with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote. (8-0).

AB 136: Places restrictions on payment of compensation for unemployment.

Mr. Jeffrey moved to INDEFINITELY POSTPONE AB 136, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried unanimously by the members present, with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote. (8-0).

AB 408: Amends provisions of laws relating to industrial insurance.

Mr. Thompson presented Amendment 476 to AB 408. EXHIBIT B (attached to these minutes).

Mr. Thompson moved to AMEND AND DO PASS AB 408, seconded by Mr. Bennett and carried unanimously by the members present, with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote. (8-0).

AB 407: Provides certain increases in compensation under industrial insurance for permanent partial disability.

Mr. Jeffrey explained Amendment 518 to AB 407. EXHIBIT C (attached to these minutes).

Miss Foley moved AMEND AND DO PASS on AB 407, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried by a vote of 6-2 with Mr. Rackley and Mr. Rhoads voting no, and with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote.

AB 370: Providing disqualifications for receipt of extended benefits as unemployment compensation.

Mr. Jeffrey will get an amendment which will provide that if the federal government eases off of this requirement, the state law will be no more severe than the federal requirement.

Mr. Jeffrey moved AMEND AND DO PASS on AB 370, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried unanimously by the members present, with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote. (8-0).

AB 433: Increases compensation under industrial insurance for certain claimants and reduces certain compensation by amount of federal benefits under social security.

Mr. Joe Nusbaum, Chairman of Nevada Industrial Commission, explained the proposed amendment to AB 433. EXHIBIT D. (attached to these minutes).

Mr. Jeffrey moved AMEND AND DO PASS on AB 433, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried unanimously by the members present, with Mrs. Cafferata absent at the time of the vote. (8-0)

This particular amendment will provide the minimum pension offset necessary for the State law to be in compliance with Federal statutes.

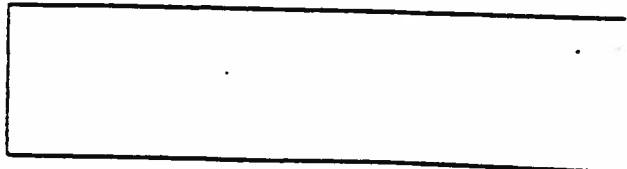

Amend section 1, page 2, by deleting lines 18 through 26 and inserting:

"wages paid during a claimant's base period." Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a person may not receive benefits for any week in which he is receiving a pension or other payment for retirement, including retirement from any public or federal employment, or an annuity or other similar periodic payment, paid by a plan which is maintained by a base period employer or an employer whose account is chargeable with benefit payments to the person, or to which such an employer has contributed. If the person contributed more than half of the amount contributed to the plan, but less than the entire amount, the benefits to which he would otherwise be entitled must be reduced by half of the amount of the pension or other payment which he is receiving. The benefit amount may not be reduced if:

(a) All of the contributions to the plan from which the person is receiving a pension or other periodic payment were made by him or by an employer other than a base period employer or an employer to whose account the benefit payments to the person are chargeable;
or

(b) Unless the payments are received pursuant to a provision of the Social Security Act or a Railroad Retirement Act, the services performed by the person during the base period, or the compensation

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO AB 433

Section 2, line 7. Change 1b to read: "To any federal social security disability income benefits [from the federal social security system]." (This underlined language specifically identifies the disability income portion of the Social Security benefits).

Section 3, lines 16, 17 and 18. Change to read: "... not entitled to an increase in those death benefits pursuant to NRS 616.628 is entitled to..." (This removes line 18 so that no dependent or survivor's Social Security benefit is affected).

Please add the following amendment which should appear as section 3 in 433; section 3 et. seq. should be renumbered as section 4 et. seq.

Sec. 3. 1. Any claimant who is not entitled to an increase provided in section 2, but who receives less in combined social security disability income benefits and workers' compensation benefits under this chapter, than 80% of the "average current earnings," as defined by 42 U.S.C. Sec. 424a, is entitled to an increase equal to the lesser of (1) the increase provided in section 2; or (2) the difference between the combined social security disability income benefit and workers' compensation benefit and 80% of the "average current earnings."

2. The increase provided by this section must not be paid for any period before July 1, 1981.
