Amend the bill as a whole by renumbering sections 4 and 5 as sections 5 and 6 and by adding a new section designated section 4, following section 3, to read as follows:

"Sec. 4. NRS 618.465 is hereby amended to read as follows:
618.465 l. If, upon inspection or investigation, the director
or his authorized representative believes that an employer has
violated a requirement of this chapter, or any standard, rule or
order [promulgated] adopted or issued pursuant to this chapter,
the department shall with reasonable promptness issue a citation to
the employer. Each citation [shall] must be in writing and [shall]
describe with particularity the nature of the violation, including
a reference to the section of this chapter or the provision of the
standard, rule, regulation or order alleged to have been violated.
In addition the citation [shall] must fix a reasonable time for the
abatement of the violation. The director may prescribe procedures
for the issuance of a notice in lieu of a citation with respect to :

- (a) [de minimis] religion violations which have no direct or immediate relationship to safety or health [.]; and
- (b) Viclations which are not serious and which the employer agrees to correct within a reasonable time.
 - 2. Each citation issued under this section, or a copy or copies thereof, [shall] <u>must</u> be prominently posted as prescribed in regulations (issued) <u>adopted</u> by the director at or near each place a violation referred to in the citation occurred.
