Chairman Banner called the meeting to order at 5:10 P.M. and informed the committee that this was a work session and no testimony would be taken.

SB-667: Authorizes coverage of industrial insurance for volunteers who work under public auspices for private organizations.

Mr. Banner told the committee that he heard the testimony in the Senate on this bill and still did not have a clear understanding of what problem the bill addresses. He asked Mr. Nusbaum to explain it to the committee.

Mr. Nusbaum explained that it was his understanding that the problem was under the displaced homemaker's program. Women who have been housewives for some time and have been out of the labor market are being brought back in to receive some training and work experience and under an agreement with a private employer they work in a semi-training capacity. They are not paid for that work, it is performed just for the experience and work for several months.

Senator Ford introduced this bill in the Senate and wanted to see that these women were covered by workmens' compensation. The bill would require the sponsoring public agency to cover the person while they are in the training status. An amendment was added to the bill in the Senate and the NIC has no problem with the amended bill.

Mr. Banner explained that a hearing has not yet been held in the Assembly on this bill and asked the committee if they wanted to schedule one. No hearing date was set.

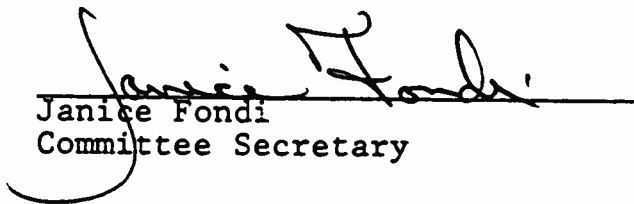
