

The special meeting of the Assembly Committee on Taxation was called to order by Chairman May at 12:15 pm with the following members present:

A.B. 369 - Increases rate of local school support tax and city-county relief tax and provides for adjustment of certain property valuations.

Chairman May asked for discussion and/or a motion to adopt the proposed amendment to A.B. 369. There being no discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Bergevin to "amend and do pass as amended" seconded by Mrs. Westall and carried by a vote of 7 to 4. Voting "nay" were Messrs. Brady, Craddock, Price and Stewart.

Mr. Price then introduced a motion to adopt a proposed amendment (Amendment No. 541) which would create a sunset provision to be triggered on the 1st of July, 1983. At that time, the school rate would go from $1\frac{1}{2}\%$ back to 1% that it is currently; the city-county relief tax would go back to $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% and would bring the sales tax rate back to what it is currently.

The motion was seconded by Mr. Stewart and carried by a vote of 6 to 4. Voting "nay" were Messrs. Bergevin, Marvel and Rusk and Mrs. Cafferata. Absent and not voting was Mrs. Westall

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
