STANDING RULES OF THE ASSEMBLY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE 61ST SESSION, 1981

- The authority and procedures of the committee are determined by:
 - Constitution of the State of Nevada;

b. Nevada Revised Statutues;

Standing rules of the Nevada Assembly; Standing rules of the Assembly Transportation Committee; and

Mason's Manual of Parliamentary Procedure.

II. Duties of the Chairman:

Prepare the agenda;

ъ. Call committee together;

Require minutes to be kept and presented at following c. meeting;

Prepare committee reports;

Appoint subcommittee, as needed; and

Notify all members in advance of special meetings.

Duties of the Vice Chairman: III.

In the absence or at the discretion of the Chairman, the Vice Chairman shall conduct the meetings of the committee.

Committee action: IV.

A quorum shall consist of at least five (5) members of the committee.

A quorum must be present to hear a bill or resolution.

- A simple majority of the total committee can pass or reject a bill or resolution.
- Six (6) committee members shall be required to reconsider d. a bill or resolution.

Attendance shall be recorded. e.

"No" votes shall be recorded.

- Committee members shall address the Chair to gain the floor.
- The Chairman shall determine when a final action is to be taken after witnesses have been questioned and dismissed. The secretary shall record the action of the committee by roll call vote.

Committee introduction requires concurrence of five (5) members of the committee and does not imply commitment or support of the bill or resolution.

No smoking in the committee room.

Recesses shall be at the call of the Chair. k.

- All meetings shall be open to the public and media. m.
