The Chairman asked the members to review the proposed committee rules and the following rules were adopted:

SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

COMMITTEE RULES - 61ST SESSION

- 1. Four members constitute a quorum of the committee
- Motions will be moved, seconded, and passed by a simple majority of those present, except that definite action (Do pass or Hold) on a bill will require a majority of the entire committee.
- 3. In order to reconsider previous actions taken, an affirmative vote of five (5) members of the committee will be required. However, a majority present may allow the hearing of new evidence or information which would be pertinent to the determination of whether or not a matter or an action should be reconsidered.
- 4. Mason's Manual will be followed as to parliamentary procedure.

- 5. Any member of the committee may request an item on the agenda by contacting the committee chairman.
- 6. Committee bill introduction will be only by unanimous approval of the committee members present. Committee introduction does not imply in any way a commitment on the part of any committee member to support the bill introduced.
- 7. The Transportation Committee has an assigned meeting time of P.M. Adjournment in Room 323 and will meet at that time. Members are urged to plan their work so that they can be present at each meeting and can be available at the appointed hour.
- 8. A Minority Report must be requested at the time a bill or resolution is reported out of committee and the Minority Report to be filed with the Secretary of the Senate must be individually signed by each member requesting it.

Senator Jacobsen moved that the Senate Transportation Committee Rules be approved.

Senator Bilbray seconded the motion.

The motion carried unanimously.

Senator Blakemore stated that in addition to the above rules the Chairman would be the first to question each witness. Any additional questioning would be determined by a show of hands.

Senator Blakemore asked the committee if they would approve a committee introduction of the following bills and resolutions: Senate Bill, BDR 43-96; Senate Bill, BDR 43-97; Senate Bill, BDR 43-389; Senate Concurrent Resolution, BDR 98; Senate Concurrent Resolution, BDR 98; and Senate Concurrent Resolution, BDR 100.

Senator Jacobsen moved that above senate bills and resolutions be introduced by the Transportation Committee.

Senator Bilbray Seconded the motion.

The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:17 p.m.
