5.B. 15%	Removes certain expenses of department of motor vehicles from state highway fund. (Senate Bill)
B.D.R. 43-290 S.B. 159	Changes certain provisions of law relating to drivers' licenses. (Senate Bill)
B.D.R. C-444 5.J.R15	Proposes to amend Nevada constitution to broaden permissible uses of state highway fund. (Senate Joint Resolution)
B.D.R. 35-42 S.B. 156	Removes statute made obsolete by repeal of federal law relating to the public lands. (Senate Bill)
B.D.R. 35-279 <u>S.B. 157</u>	Makes certain changes in bidding requirements and partial payments for road contracts (Senate Bill)

Senate Committee on Transportation January 29, 1981

B.D.R. 32-281 Increases and changes measure of tax on motor vehicle fuel and special fuel. (Senate Bill)

B.D.R. 35-278 Provides for sidewalks in state-owned rights of way. (Senate Bill)
