Enacted joint resolutions are those passed by the Legislature and assigned a file number in the Statues of Nevada. Joint resolutions which seek to amend the Nevada Constitution must be passed by two Sessions of the Legislature and then be submitted to the people for a vote.

Enacted concurrent and one-house resolutions are those adopted by the Legislature and assigned a file number in the Statutes of Nevada.
