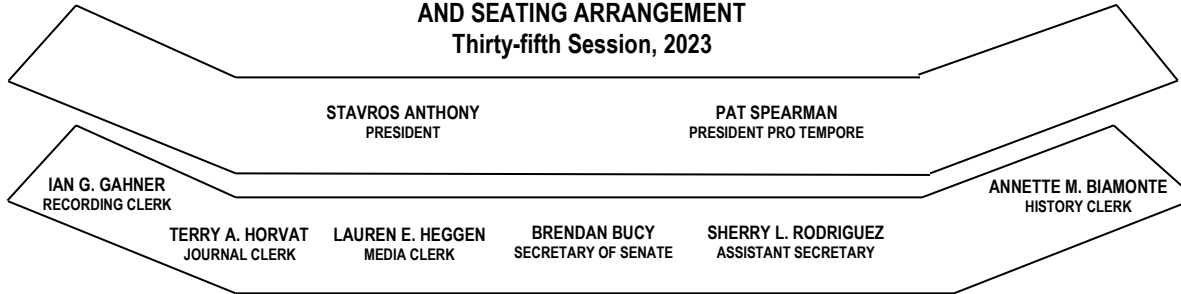

### S.B. 1—Committee of the Whole, Jun. 7.

Summary—Revises provisions governing economic infrastructure projects.  
(BDR S-9) Fiscal Note: Effect on Local Government: May have Fiscal Impact.  
Effect on the State: Contains Appropriation not included in Executive Budget.
