Purpose:

- 1. To revise and clarify both existing and amended language in section 1(5) of the bill, which relates to the active experience requirement for an applicant for a license as a professional engineer.
- 2. To revise and clarify both existing and amended language in section 3(5) of the bill, which relates to the active experience requirement for an applicant for a license as a professional land surveyor.

Recommended changes:

- 1. Revise both existing and amended language in section 1(5) of the bill to provide that:
- (a) Only 4 of the 10 years of required active experience may be satisfied by the completion of course work.
- (b) Of those 4 years of course work, only 2 years may be course work that is not approved by the Board.
 - (c) To be approved by the Board, such course work must relate to engineering.
- 2. Revise both existing and amended language in section 3(5) of the bill to provide that:
- (a) Only 4 of the 10 years of required active experience may be satisfied by the completion of course work.
- (b) Of those 4 years of course work, only 2 years may be course work that is not approved by the Board.
 - (c) To be approved by the Board, such course work must relate to land surveying.
