- A.B. 419 Provides that landlord of dwelling units intended and operated for persons 55 years of age and older may not employ person to perform work on premises unless person has work card issued by sheriff. (BDR 10-833)
- A.B. 2 Limits right of employer to own certain intellectual property developed by employee. (BDR 52-365)
- A.B. 81 Authorizes award for treble damages, attorney's fees and costs in certain civil actions relating to marks. (BDR 52-366)
- A.B. 288 Provides for judicial approval of certain contracts involving minors. (BDR 11-1116)
- A.B. 478 Revises provisions relating to registration of certain businesses regulated by Division of Consumer Affairs of the Department of Business and Industry. (BDR 52-1249)
- A.B. 497 Exempts licensed child care facility from regulation as food establishment. (BDR 40-1199)
